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Section 1 - Methodology

A sample of 500 Maltese residents was collected from the general Maltese population aged 18 years and over. This denotes a sample with a 95% confidence level and a 4.38% confidence interval. The data was collected during May 2012 and telephone interviews were the method of data collection. Scientific imputation techniques were used where necessary to impute values for missing responses (no-response).
